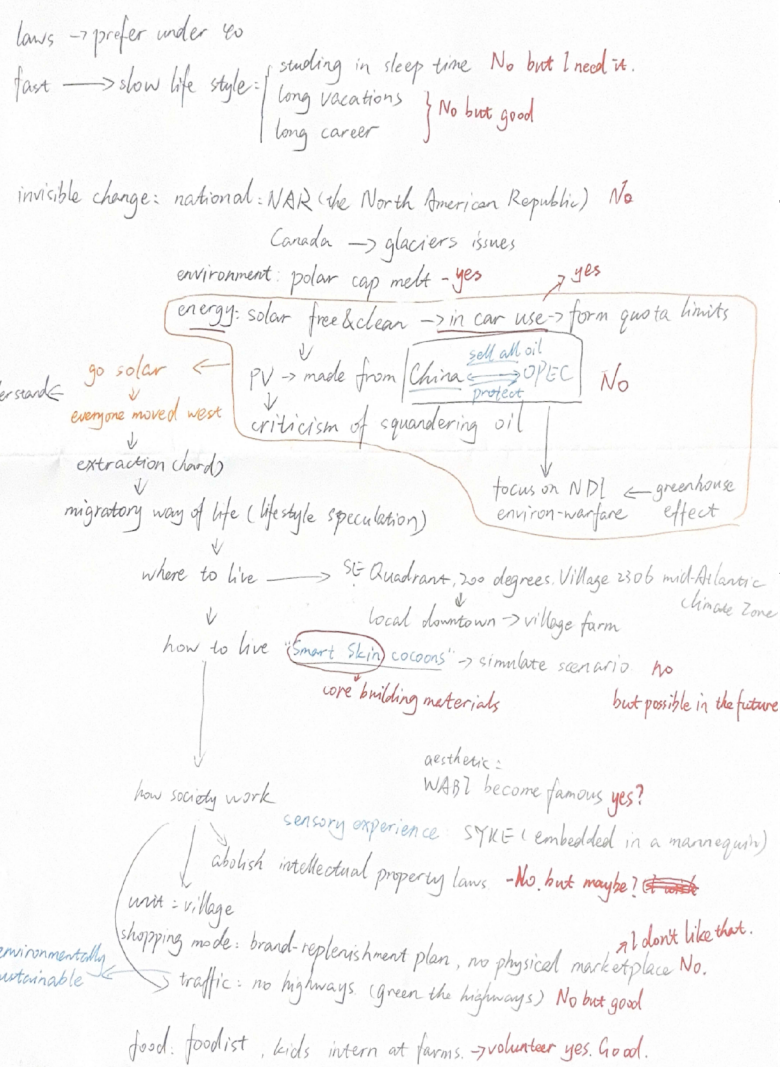

AI-related laws are being gradually improved; in education, measures are taken to prevent students from over-reliance on AI for homework, such as AI companies launching student-specific AI versions and schools requiring students to submit assignment processes.

Biometric tracking technology is applied in lost-and-found services (via fingerprint-recording film on products for location tracking) and payment methods; in 2035, physical stores will adopt checkout-free shopping, where payments are confirmed and deducted from linked bank cards through fingerprints in designated areas.

Driverless technology is widely rolled out, covering driverless taxis and unmanned door-to-door delivery that is gradually replacing couriers; people can choose between manual delivery and home transportation pipelines, with drones mainly for food delivery and pipelines for other goods.

The popularity of checkout-free shopping and unmanned delivery results in fewer simple technical jobs and reduced human interactions.

Green energy is promoted in transportation; aircraft start using clean energy like hydrogen, and Airbus developed the first hydrogen-powered aircraft in 2035, which has not been put on the market yet.
